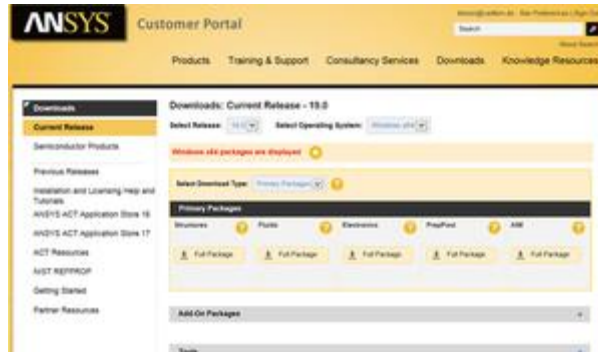


ANSYS Release 19.2 – Installation

Notes on installation



The software can be downloaded as usual via the ANSYS Customer Portal ;
https://support.ansys.com/AnsysCustomerPortal/en_us

For new customers, the creation of a user login is required before the download. This registration requires the current customer number.

To download the ANSYS software we recommend downloading the ISO images. With this download option, you get all the data and do not have to assemble single modules into an installation archive. It is not necessary to burn a DVD as the loaded ISO images can also be unpacked with the appropriate tools such as 7-Zip (please use the current version!) Or WinRAR. Please DO NOT use the Windows own Zip Utility or WinZip as they could not unpack the images correctly. The individual ISO images must always be unpacked into their own folders in order to avoid overwriting files of the same name.

Electromagnetic products such as ANSYS Maxwell, ANSYS Simplorer, ANSYS Slwave and others have a separate ZIP installation package (Electronics) on the ANSYS Customer Portal. Further information on the current ANSYS Release 19.2 is available in the download menu under "Getting Started". These notes include information about: Highlights of Release, Platform Support Documents, Important Notices, Downloads & Prerequisites, Installation;

ANSYS 19.2 only supports 64bit operating systems. This applies to the licensing as well as to the client / server installation of the ANSYS software. More information about platform support is available at the following link:

Compatibility with Previous Releases

Backwards Compatibility: ANSYS 19.2 was tested to read and resume databases from the following previous versions: 19.1, 19.0 and 18.x. Note that some products are read-only and resume databases from releases prior to 18.0. Please see the specific product sections below for more details. For those products that can not read directly a 17.x database in 19.2, first resume it in 18.x and then resume that database in 19.2.

Upward / Forward Compatibility: No previous release has the ability to read and resume a database from a more recent release.

Advisories

In addition to the incompatibilities noted in the release notes, known non-operational behavior, errors and / or limitations at the time of release are documented in the Known Issues and Limitations document, although not accessible via the ANSYS Help Viewer. See the ANSYS customer site or online for the ANSYS service packs and any additional items not included in the Known Issues and Limitations document. First-time users of the customer must register to create a password.

For a list of issues and limitations in Release 19.2, refer to the Resolved Issues and Limitations document on the ANSY Help site.

Project names and paths should not include Japanese or Chinese characters. ANSYS, Inc. products, including the flagship products and Workbench add-ins. The restriction applies the user interface is localized or not.
