

ANSYS Release 19.2 – Licensing

Notes on licensing

When updating to version 19.2, all existing license server systems must first be updated to the new release. Please note that only 64bit operating systems are supported. The list of officially supported license server operating systems includes:

- Windows 7 (Professional & Enterprise)
- Windows 10 (Professional & Enterprise & Education)
- Windows Server 2012 R2
- Windows Server 2016
- Red Hat Enterprise 6.8 and 6.9
- Red Hat Enterprise 7.2, 7.3 and 7.4
- SuSE Linux Enterprise Server 11 SP3 and SP4
- SuSE Linux Enterprise Server & Desktop 12 SP1, SP2 and SP3
- CentOS 7.3 and 7.4

Furthermore, please check before the license server update if your license key is suitable for this use. In this case, the release date of the new version 19.2 must be before the maintenance expiration date of the corresponding license increment. Since version 19.2 only supports TRL licensing (temper resistant licensing), the license key must have a required "SIGN2 key" in every increment.

By ordering a maintenance extension, the ASC (ANSYS Support Coordinator) automatically receives a current license file. If necessary, please contact our contract department: license@cadfem.de. After each maintenance renewal, the obtained license files must be imported to ensure availability of the current licenses and compatibility with newer versions of ANSYS.

If you want to change the license server, you can apply for the new license in the ANSYS Customer Portal under "License Management" -> "License Server Change". Please note that the Online Server Change can only be done by the ANSYS Support Coordinator (ASC).

The file setupLM.exe has been replaced by the -LM command option. This command can be used in conjunction with setup.exe for both command line and silent installation (example: setup.exe -LM or setup.exe -silent -LM).

The FlexNet Client (used in electronics products) has been updated to version 11.13.1.4. Therefore, as of version R19.0, the **ANSYS License Manager** is absolutely necessary for the **electronics products** . The ansoft license manager is no longer used.
